- We have a special discount for our location only. For adults (age 19 and up) the cost is \$50, but is discounted to \$35 by using the promo code "EastTenth". For young people (up to and including age 18) the cost is \$25 but is discounted to \$20 using the code "EastTenthYouth". Those codes are available to everyone who is registering to participate at our location. However, they are not valid for any other locations.
