- Please complete these forms and return them to the church office no later than this Thursday, May 31. To protect your personal information, please hand completed forms directly to Dave or Lauren on Sundays; or drop them off at the church office during the week.
- Beginning next Sunday, youth workers who have not yet completed a background check will be asked to complete one at the time they come to serve. This applies to all adults serving in any capacity with children or youth, or serving in the nursery.
- There is an attached sheet which you can keep (or see Dave if you would like another copy). Please note that the company we are utilizing runs a variety of types of background checks for many different industries. The sheet attached to the background check is standard information which they include for each check, and which we are required to provide to you. Please note our basic background checks provide identity verification, a nationwide criminal database check and a sex offender registry check. We are **not** running any credit check or obtaining any financial information on anyone.
